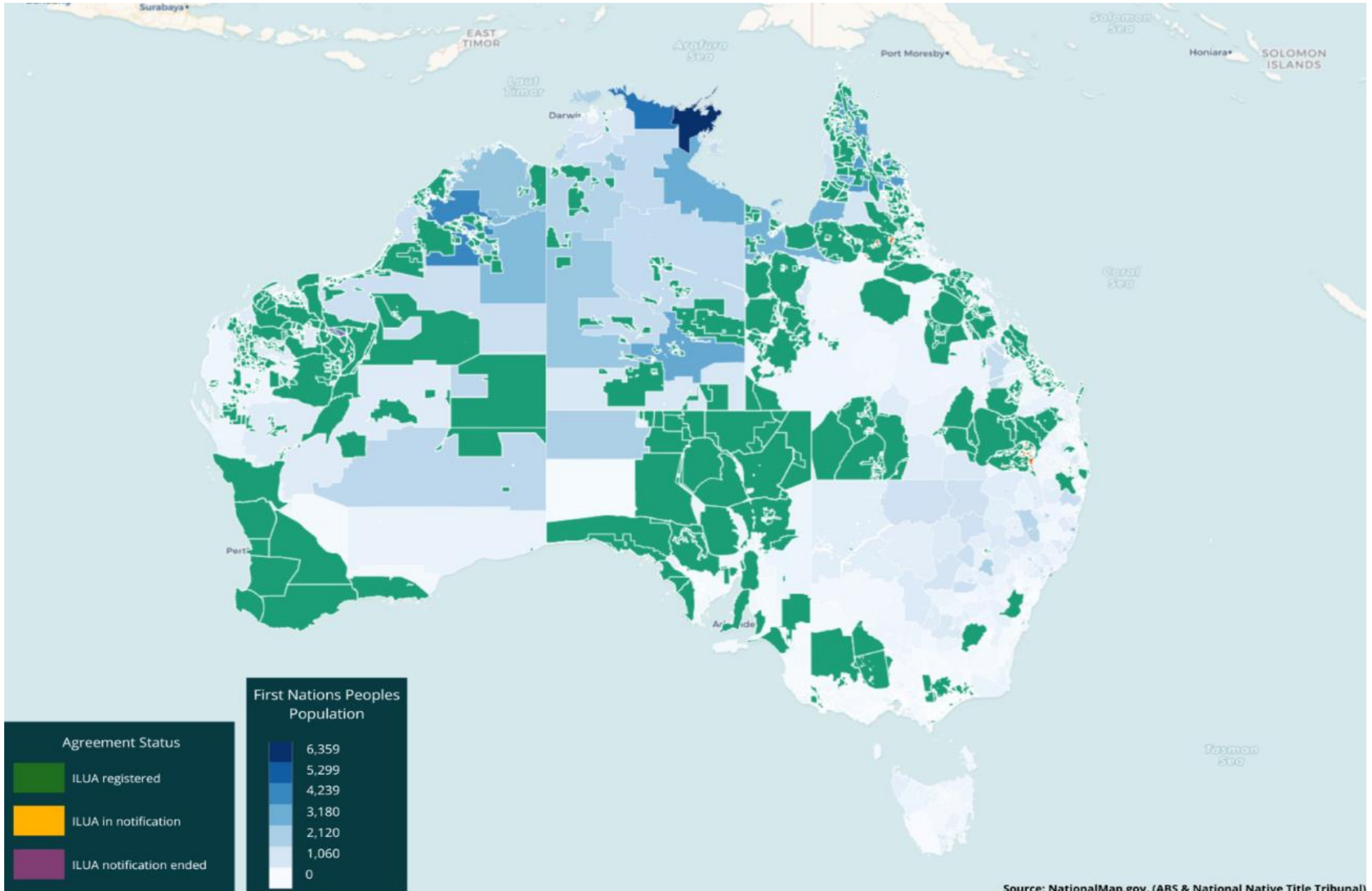


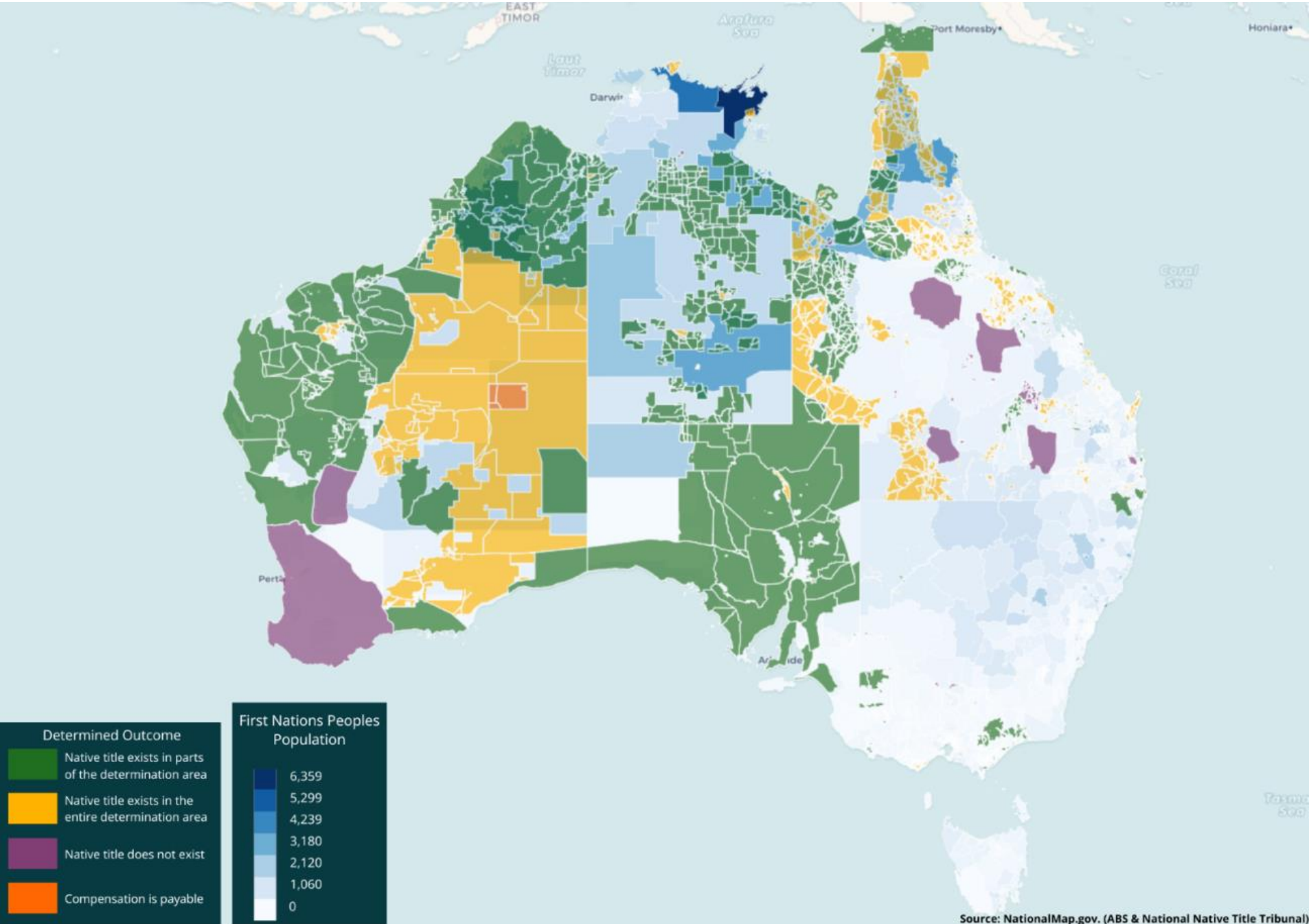
## APPENDIX D: Maps

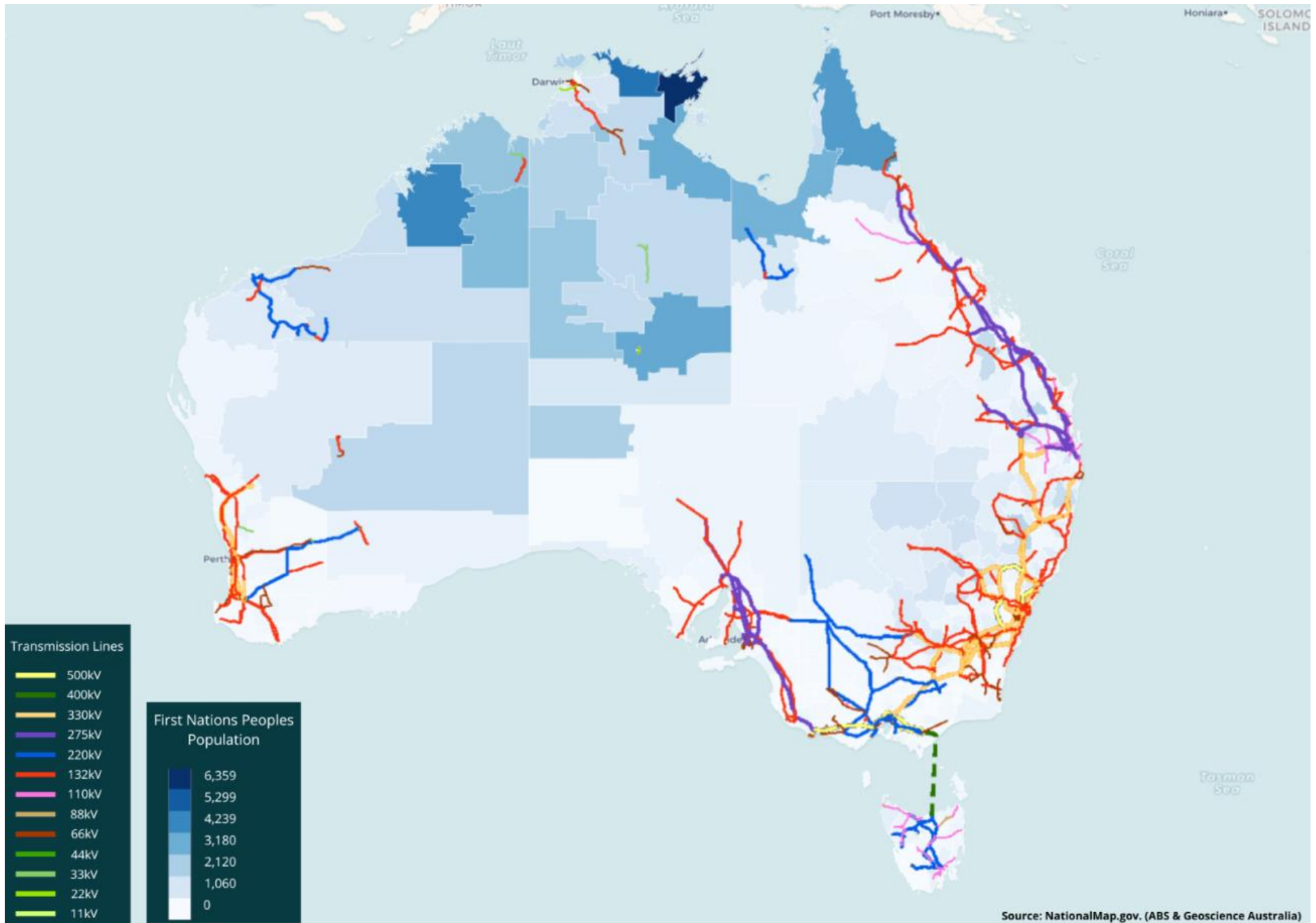

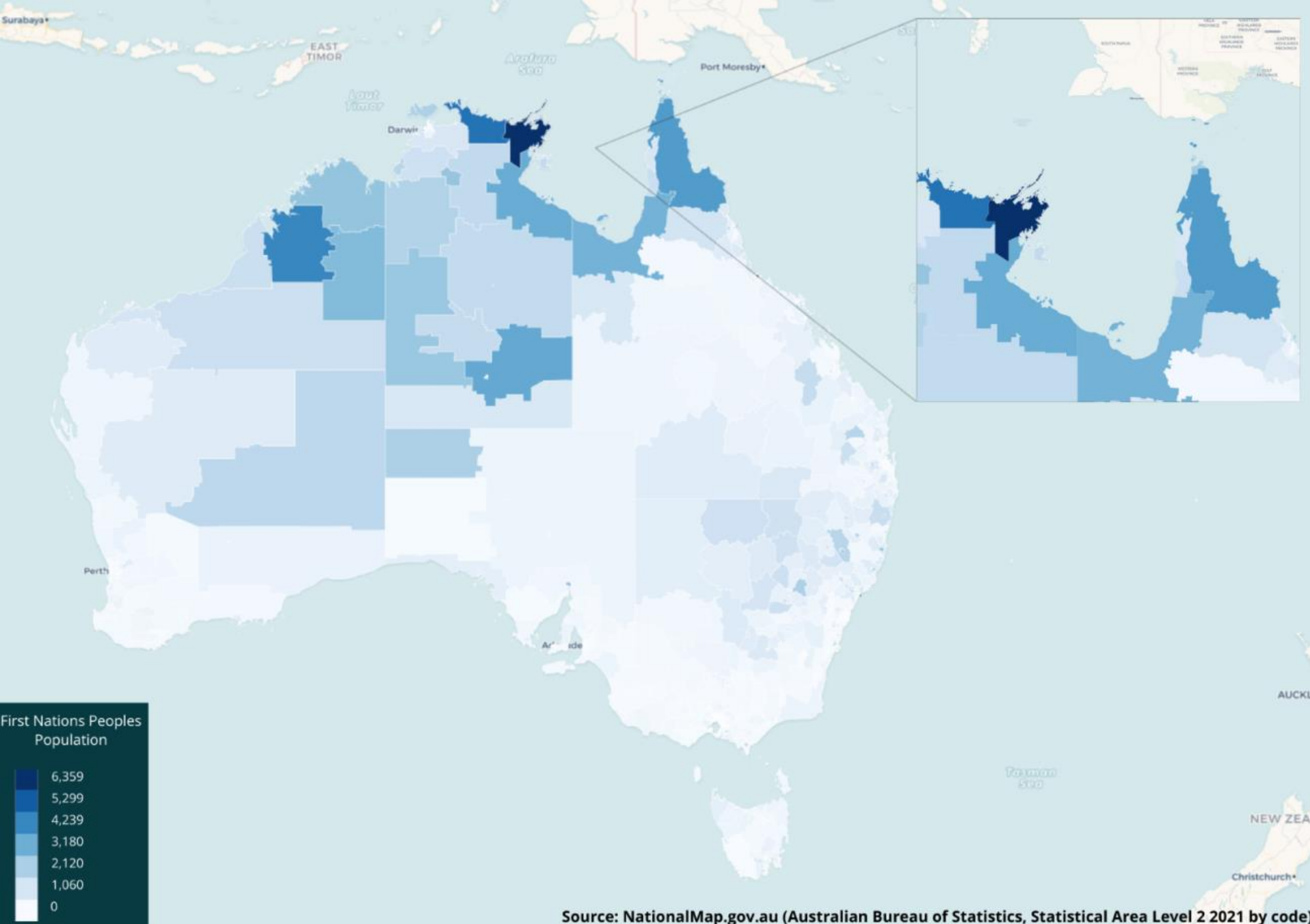
Map 1: This map illustrates the intersection between the First Nations population across Australia and the current Indigenous Land Use Agreements.
